nen suffering and pain come into our lives, we instinctively ask "Why? Why me? Why should this happen to my family? Why did God allow this? Why doesn't

God do something about this?" These kinds of questions are the most difficult to answer. Also, I suspect that even if we knew the reasons for the suffering and problems in our lives, it would not make them any easier to handle. In fact,

knowing the reasons for the suffering might even intensify the pain!

Today in our passage from Romans, Paul gives us insight into dealing with suffering. Being a follower of Jesus does not render us immune from problems and struggles. Yet, we are to look beyond the pain and suffering to our Lord Jesus Christ. He was described as "the Man of Sorrows" but has conquered sin, suffering, and evil. He still says: "In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). ■
