

Calvary Freedom Cup Cricket Tournament Volunteer Needs

Hospitality Crew (2 volunteers each game) will welcome players to our fields as they arrive. They will also engage non-players in friendly dialogue to make them feel welcomed. Volunteers will also serve water and Gatorade mixes for the players (Coolers and cups will be provided).

1. Volunteers will come at least 15 minutes before the game time. For example, if the game starts at 8:00 AM, please plan to be there at 7:45 AM.
2. If the water coolers are not prepared, please go to concession area at the pavilion (located on the main CHAMP fields). Fill one cooler with water and the other with Gatorade mix. Instruction to mix Gatorade will be available at the pavilion. Cups will also be available in the pavilion.
3. Carts will be available to move the coolers and cups from the pavilion to Rea Road field.
4. The coolers may need refill during the game. Hospitality volunteers will be responsible to make sure there is enough ice and water/Gatorade in the coolers. To refill, volunteers will take the coolers back to pavilion, fill it and bring it back. Please make use of the carts.

Field Crew (2 volunteers each game) will help with all needs pertaining to the field.

1. Volunteers will arrive 15 minutes before the game time. Volunteers will help team and field captains to get the pitch and field ready for the next game.
2. As needed, volunteers will help with pitch marking, running roller on the pitch, and other needed tasks.
3. If a player hits the ball into the backfields, side or parking lot, field crew will help retrieve the ball.
4. Volunteers will also help with other needs where a trip to main building is necessary.
5. Volunteers will also help with clean up after the last game for the day in preparation for Sunday.

Game Coordinators (1 -3 each Saturday) will oversee volunteer teams and the playing teams on Saturdays.

1. Game coordinator may serve one game (8:00– 9:30 AM) or multiple games, 3rd game starts 12:30 PM.
2. Game coordinator will make sure all that is needed for the game is in place.
3. Any issues must be promptly reported to Cricket Outreach coordinator or in his/her absence, pastor of Outreach.
4. Assign dugouts for the playing teams.
5. Welcome the playing teams as they arrive, direct them to their dugout, and instruct them to attend the devotion and prayer before the games.
6. Welcome the devotional speaker as he arrives and direct him to the field 10 minutes before the game start time. Instruct all players and volunteers to attend devotion and prayer.
7. Before the devotion, game coordinator will welcome the teams to Calvary fields, introduce the speaker and the playing teams to each other and hand off to the speaker.
