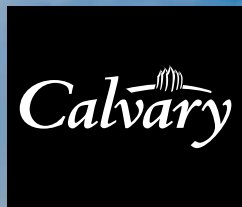
## Next Sunday the annual Calvary Missions Conference begins!

## Called to serve

Before Paul's conversion, he was a persecutor of the church. On his way to Damascus to imprison followers of Jesus Christ, he was confronted with a great light from heaven. Paul asked two questions. The first was, "Who

are you, Lord?" Up to that point he regarded Jesus as an imposter, but then he realized that Jesus is the living God.

His second question was, "What shall I do, Lord?" The Lord commissioned him to be the apostle to the

Gentiles (Acts 22:1–21). Most of us understand that Jesus is the Son of God, the Savior of the world. Now the question is, "What shall I do, Lord?" While the Apostle Paul had a unique calling, we will learn this morning that each one of us is called by God to serve. We are also gifted by the triune God for that service. There is no higher calling!

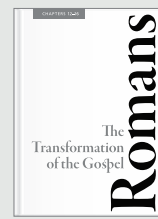

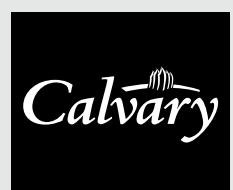
