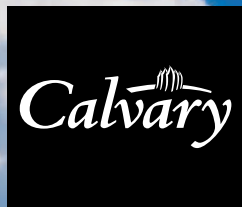

Understanding Scripture

Because Calvary believes that the Bible is the Word of God, we are committed to preaching and teaching it, studying it, meditating

on it, memorizing it, and obeying it! We believe that "all Scripture is inspired by God" (2 Timothy 3:16). Paul "did not shrink from declaring the whole counsel of God" (Acts 20:27). At Calvary, we want to follow that example.

Some parts of Scripture are easy to understand and seem very relevant to our situation. Other parts are more difficult to understand, and we sometimes wonder whether it is really worthwhile to study them! But God is wiser than we are, and He has given us 66 books for our salvation, profit, and instruction.

Tonight in our continuing study of the life of David, we will consider the "Davidic Covenant." It may seem a rather remote and irrelevant subject, but the biblical covenants are foundational in understanding the unfolding purposes of God. This Sunday and next, we will think of the Davidic Covenant—its meaning, its relevance, and its fulfillment in our Lord Jesus Christ. It will not only deepen your love of Scripture but your love of our magnificent Savior. ■
