## MILITARY

**Pray for God's guidance and protection for our military here and around the world.**

*"He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the LORD, 'My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust.'" — Psalm 91:1–2*

Courageous leaders who look to the Lord for wisdom and hope (Psalm 91)

Perseverance to endure hardship in all circumstances (2 Corinthians 12:9–10)

Protection and support for families

Chaplains who are divinely appointed to offer true hope and spiritual strength from God's Word (2 Timothy 2:15)

## CHURCH

**Pray that the Church would have a renewed zeal and commitment to preaching and teaching God's Word and evangelizing the world.**

*"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations." — Matthew 28:19*

A return to the absolutes of Scripture (2 Timothy 3: 16–17)

God's people to conduct their lives with integrity (2 Corinthians 5:18–21)

A holy fear of the Lord to be released in the hearts of God's people (Proverbs 1:7)

Unity among churches that truly proclaim the Gospel (John 17:3)

## FAMILY

**Pray for Christ-centered homes where family members desire to fulfill their God-given roles.**

A return to biblical values that serve the nation as a whole (Deuteronomy 4:9)

God's name to be hallowed and His will to be done in Christian homes (Matthew 6:9–10)

Husbands and wives to honor the Lord by serving each other through their God-given roles (Ephesians 5:22–33)

Parents to be faithful in raising their children (Ephesians 6:1–4)

Forgiveness to be granted where necessary for the re-establishment of family relationships (Ephesians 4:32)
